### AREA OF OPERATION

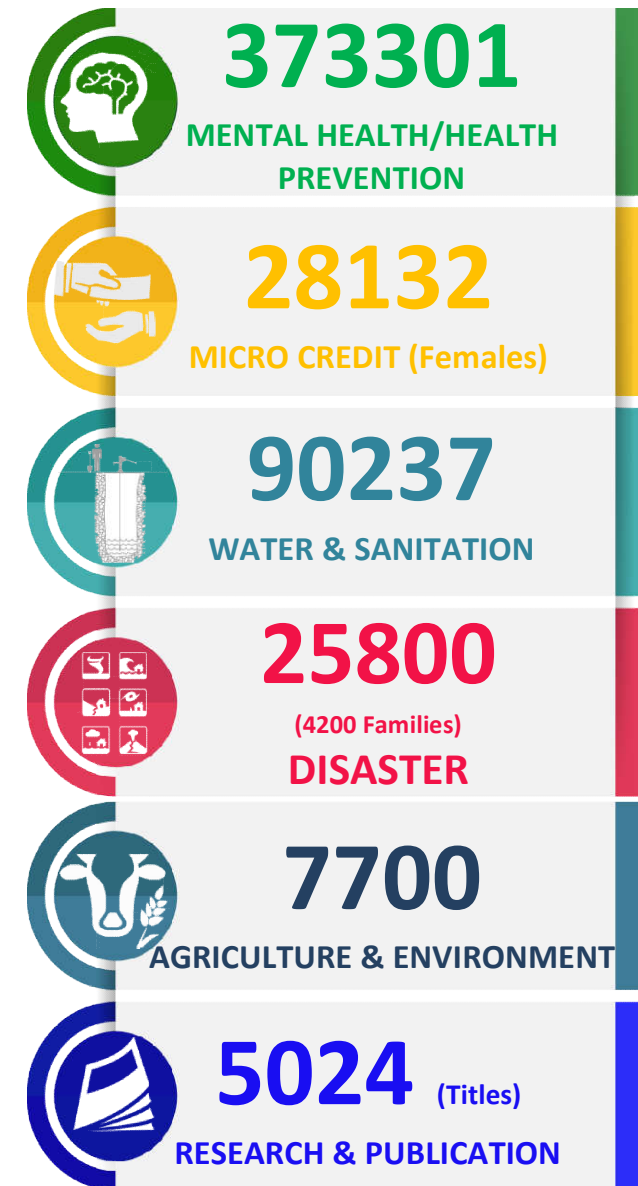
